

SAFETY EQUIPMENT

Exit Door

- Any door that leads to the hallway
- Front door only
- NOT the two doors on the side wall.

Fire Drill Procedures

- Push your chair in
- Get into a single file line
- Remain SILENT
- Exit the room and follow directions as we head out to the tennis courts.

“Shelter”

- Everyone must stay in the classroom
- Class instruction can continue

“Lockdown”

- Lights out
- Doors locked
- SILENCE
- Crouch down in corner of room

Chemical Storage Room

- Students are NEVER permitted to enter the storage room.

Fire Blanket

- Used on a person
- Call teacher to get the blanket in a fire emergency

Safety Shower (“Chemical Shower”)

- Yell for teacher to report a chemical spill or splatter on a person
- Stand under shower for 15 – 20 minutes / until paramedics arrive.

Eye Wash

- Yell for teacher to report a chemical spill or splatter in someone’s eyes.
- Put your eyes in the wash sockets for 15 – 20 minutes / until paramedics arrive.

Emergency Gas Shut-Off

- GOLD button next to exit door.
- Push the button (somewhat forcefully) into the wall when gas is ON and becomes unsafe.

Fire

Extinguisher

- Next to exit door.
- Used on non-living things

Fume Hood

- Used when working with chemicals that are harmful to the respiratory tract (nasal passages, trachea, lungs, etc.)

Goggles

- Used to protect eyes when working with chemicals or substances that are eye irritant.

Aprons

- Used when working with chemicals or substances that irritate the skin.
